### Landholder Payment Review

#### Overview

- Powerlink embarked on a review of our Network Development Process (NDP) in September 2022.
- Powerlink's landholder payment approach is one of the elements included in the NDP review.
- We undertook a collaborative process to develop a revised compensation framework guided by a dedicated stakeholder reference group.
- The landholder payment element was prioritised in the NDP review and a new landholder payment framework has now been finalised.



### **Feedback Themes**

#### Key Feedback

- There is a significant increase in community and stakeholder expectations of engagement and compensation.
- Money alone will not 'buy' the corridor, with strong emphasis remaining on sound early engagement processes and broader investment in community and social performance.
- Different options are required in the timing of compensation payments.
- Other impacted landholders and stakeholders (e.g. adjacent landholders and Traditional Owner groups) are not considered appropriately in current schemes.
- Schemes applying flat rate payments can create inequity across different land values.

### New SuperGrid Landholder Payment Framework

#### Significantly boosts payments to hosting landholders

Flexibility in timing of payments to hosting landholders First transmission company in Australia to offer payments to adjacent landholders

Provide payment estimates to landholders earlier in the process.



## Hosting Landholders

Payments for hosting landholders will:

- Continue to be underpinned by compensation in accordance with Acquisition of Land Act (ALA)
- Include a significant uplift in commercial incentive
- Continue to received fixed amount for professional fees allowances





## Adjacent Landholders

Payments for adjacent landholders will:

- Be based on the amount of land within a 1km radius of the transmission line
- Apply a proportional allowance considering specific project impacts
